system to the next level. "Given that remote doctor consultation will continue even after the pandemic ends, the digital access to patient data can be a game

"Most importantly, this will improve access by providing a big boost to consultation through telemedicine with specialist doctors for patients in smaller towns and remote locations," Sehgal stated.

In his speech, Modi said, "Every Indian will be given a health ID. This health ID will work as each Indian's health account." Every test, disease and diagnosis, and medical reports along with medicines will be stored in every citizen's health ID.

These health issues will be resolved through this National Digital Health Mission, he said while announcing the scheme.

Apollo Hospitals Group chairman Prathap C Reddy said, even as the world grappled with the coronavirus pandemic, India is at the forefront of developing a vaccine "with several companies having made excellent progress".

"I am optimistic that within a year, we will have a vaccine," he said while also drawing attention to non-communicable diseases (NCDs) that "pose a bigger threat to the future of humanity and account for close to 80% of global mortality".

"Bearing this hard reality in mind, it is very important that patients battling chronic diseases do not neglect their health any longer on account of the pandemic and seek timely medical attention. Further, a delay could also lead to emergencies on account of uncontrolled progression of NCDs, choking the medical ecosystem in our country," Reddy said. He further said, "Overcoming this crisis and a resolute determination to be free from NCDs must be our collective goal on Independence Day 2020. Just as we are combating Covid-19, similarly, a war against NCDs must be an equally important imperative for India as the prevalence of these diseases is becoming younger."





J&K polls after delimitation says PM

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA Modi on Saturday announced that elections would be held in Jammu and Kashmir as soon as the delimitation process in the union territory gets over.

In his Independence Day address to the nation, the PM, who spoke on development in various parts of the country, noted that it had been a year since Jammu and Kashmir, and Ladakh got independence from Article 370. "This one year has been a very important milestone for the new development journey of these regions as it gave women and dalits of this region their basic rights besides dignity to the lives of our refugee brethren," Modi said.

He also referred to the 'Back to Villages' initiative of the administration of the union territory administration and said it ensured the fruits of developments reached the villages and the poor. Under the scheme, all bureaucrats spent time in villages to address the problems of the people. "I thank the panches and sarpanches from the core of my heart for their active participation in this development journey," Modi said. The strength and real power of democracy lies in elected local bodies, Modi said. It is a matter of pride that the public representatives of these local bodies are taking forward the development process in Jammu and Kashmir with their active participation and concern, he added.

"The delimitation exercise is going on in Jammu and

Kashmir under the chairmanship of a retired Supreme Court judge. As soon as the delimitation process is over, there will be elections in the future so that the union territory has its own government, which will undertake development work with renewed vigour," Modi said. The process of delimitation of Lok Sabha and assembly constituencies in the union territory was set in motion with the appointment of former Supreme Court judge Ranjana Prakash Desai as chairperson of the Delimitation Commission in March this year.

The delimitation exercise will be carried out in accordance with the provisions of the JK Reorganisation Act of 2019 that split the state into two UTs of Jammu and Kashmir with an assembly and Ladakh without an assembly. Delimitation in Jammu and Kashmir will be based on the Census of 2011 due to an amendment in the JK Reorganisation Act. The number of assembly seats in Jammu and Kashmir after delimitation will increase from 107 to 114, including 24 seats for Pakistan-occupied Kashmir. Before Jammu and Kashmir was reorganised, there were 46 assembly seats in Kashmir, 37 in Jammu and four in Ladakh. After delimitation, Jammu is likely to gain five seats and Kashmir two. During the last one year, Modi said, the Ayushman Bharat scheme has been wonderfully used in Jammu and Kashmir, and Ladakh. By making Ladakh a UT, "we have fulfilled their aspirations and a much delayed demand," he said.

J&K on new journey of normalcy, development: LG

A NEW ERA of normalcy and development has dawned in Jammu and Kashmir due to the changes effected in the last one year, Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha said on Saturday and expressed the resolve to make peace, progress and social harmony the most integral part of the transformed narrative.

"It is a matter of great sorrow that the legacy of cultural syncretism has been eclipsed by the vicious story of sectarianism. But, we want to transform the narrative once again. We want to make development, peace, progress and social harmony the most integral part of the narrative of Jammu and Kashmir," Sinha said in his Independence Day speech at Sher-e-Kashmir cricket stadium here. He said the government was committed to providing a better alternative that stands for development, welfare and social transformation for the people of J&K and urged the youths to engage in activism that helps the nation to progress.

"After the constitutional change enacted in 2019, the central government took not one or two, but historic 50 decisions to transform the face of the region. A new era of normalcy and development has dawned due to the

changes effected in the last year; a new journey has been undertaken," the LG said referring to the abrogation of Article 370 and Article 35-A in August last year.

Referring to former PM Atal Bihari Vajpayee's doctrine of 'Insaniyat, Jamhoriyat and Kashmiriyat', Sinha lamented that humanity conceded defeat to terrorism for decades in Kashmir, democracy suffered at the hands of vested interests and Kashmiriyat was massacred to appease the hatred that ensued. Sinha, who took charge on August 7, said, "Activism is not a bad thing, but to choose the correct option is of utmost significance. Your activism should be directed at the development of the nation, as this country belongs to none other than you, and you are its future leaders." The LG said the government has five main guiding principles - to put in place a just and transparent system of governance, a thriving grassroots level democracy, maximising the reach of government welfare schemes; accelerating economic development and creation of employment.

Sinha said some "wrong decisions" were unfortunately taken after independence which inevitably led to resentment in the hearts of the people of Jammu and Kashmir, and distanced them from the rest.

India has deepened ties in extended neighbourhood: Modi

NEIGHBOURS ARE NOT only those with whom one shares geographical boundaries but also those with whom hearts meet, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Saturday, asserting that India has deepened its relations with all countries in the extended neighbourhood.

Modi said India's ties with West Asian and ASEAN countries had grown manifold in key sectors.

"India is constantly trying to deepen its age-old cultural, social and economic ties with its neighbouring countries. South Asia is home to one-fourth of the world population and we can create infinite possibilities of development and prosperity of such a large number of people through cooperation," Modi said in his address to the nation from the ramparts of the Red Fort on India's 74th Independence Day.

Asserting that all leaders of the region have a big responsibility for the development and prosperity of their people, the PM said the more peace and harmony there will be in the region the better it will be for humanity.

"Today, neighbours are not only those with whom we share geographical boundaries but also those with whom our hearts meet... In recent times, India has strengthened its relations with all countries in the extended neighbourhood," Modi said.

Rapid progress has been made in India's political, economic and human relations with West Asian countries and the trust with them has also grown, he said.

"With these countries, our economic relations, especially in the energy sector, are very important. A large number of our brothers and sisters are working in these countries. The way these countries helped Indians in the times of coronavirus and honoured the Indian government's requests, India is thankful to them," he added.

ASEAN countries, which are India's maritime neighbours, are also very important for the country, India shares age-old religious and cultural ties with them, Modi said.

India is expanding cooperation with these countries not just in the security sector but also in the field of marine resources, he said.

ICICI Bank closes QIP; garners ₹15,000 cr from share sale

THE COUNTRY'S SECOND- largest private sector lender ICICI Bank on Saturday said it had completed the allotment of equity shares under its qualified institutional placement (QIP) and raised approximately ₹15,000 crore to fund its business growth and meet regulatory capital requirement. Investors were allocated 41.89 crore shares at an issue price of ₹358 per equity, the lender said in a statement. "The issue price represents a 1.9% premium to the floor price determined based on the pricing formula as prescribed

under Regulation 176(1) of the SEBI ICDR Regulations and a discount of 1.5% to the closing price of the bank's equity shares on the BSE/NSE prior to the launch of the issue," it said. Earlier this week, the bank had set a floor price at ₹351.36 per share for its QIP. The issue opened on August 10 and closed on August 14. "Pursuant to the allotment of shares, the paid-up equity share capital of the bank stands increased from ₹12,952,832,416 consisting of 6,476,416,208 equity shares of face value ₹2 each to ₹13,790,821,242 consisting of 6,895,410,621 equity shares of face value ₹2 each," it said.
